For the purpose of section 128A of the Evidence Act, the question of whether or not the third defendant has reasonable grounds for objection to the disclosure of information required to be disclosed by the order of 2 June 2021 (as extended and amended by the orders made on 7 and 10 June 2021) and whether any direction or order should be made under that section is referred to the Honourable Justice Stynes for hearing at **10:30am on 24 June 2021 (Stynes J Hearing)**.
6. The parties are to file and serve their respective submissions (not exceeding 6 pages) and any further affidavits for the Stynes J Hearing by **12:00pm on 23 June 2021**.
7. The matter is listed for directions at **10:30am on 8 October 2021**.
